


Metal Lid Owls



Step 1: Select the lids you'll use to make your owl. Arrange them in different ways, creating multiple layers. Remember: it's all about the eyes!



Step 2: Glue the parts of your owl in place. A glue gun or glue dots work well.

Materials needed:

- metal and plastic lids and caps, in a variety of sizes
- buttons
- large paperclips and/or twist ties
- hot glue or glue dots
- spray paint and/or acrylic paint
- paint brushes
- magnets, ribbon or string



Step 3: Add paint and embellishments; try paper clips or twist ties for eyebrows, buttons or faux gems for the eyes. For a mostly monochromatic owl, apply spray paint once the glue is dry, then add a few spots of color, using acrylic paint.

Step 4: Choose and attach a wire, string, or magnet to hang/display your owl.
